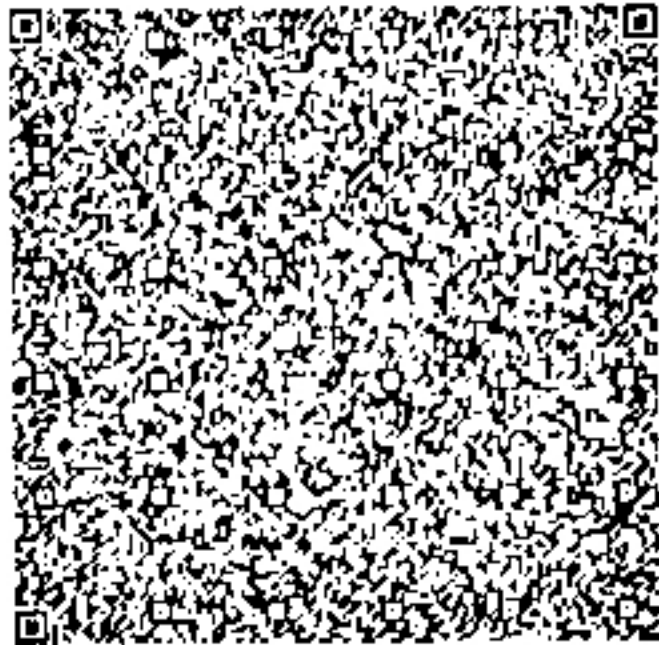

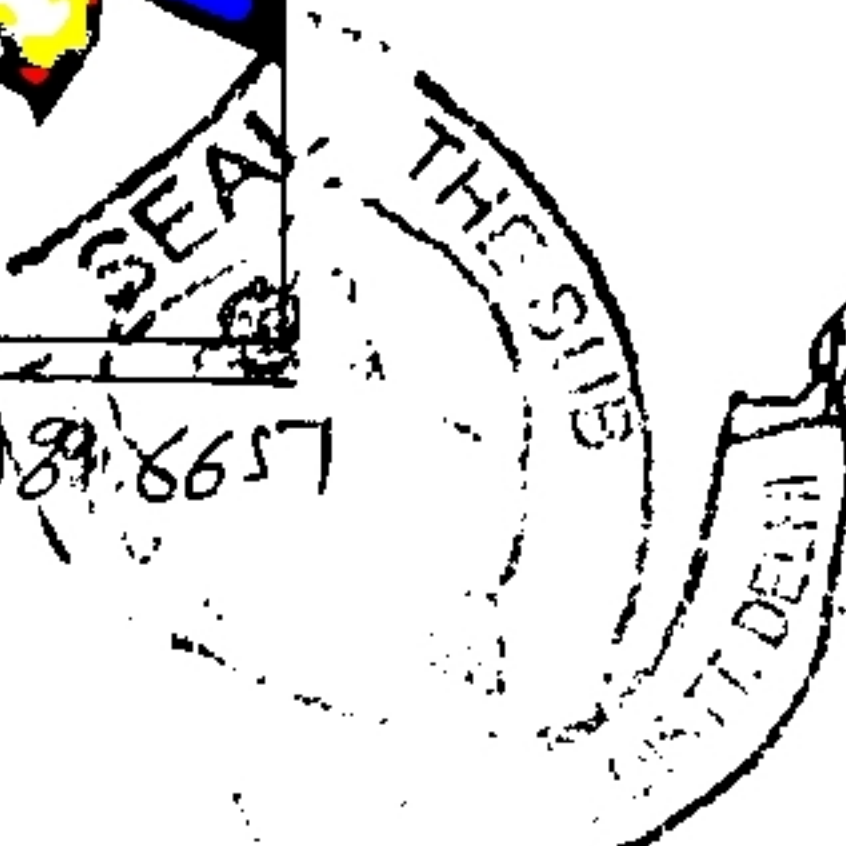


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# TRUST DEED

## INDIAN TRUST ACT 1882

The operation area of the trust will be across India.

### NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

In witnessed whereof the Authors set forth his hands and agreed upon the following terms and conditions duly set.

### NAME OF THE TRUST:-

The name of the Trust shall henceforth be known as "PARAS EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST"



**REGISTERED OFFICE:-**The registered office of the trust is located at: "Kh.No 158/1/2 Ground Floor Mukandpur Extn, Gali No-5/16 Samta Vihar Village Mukandpur Landmark Near Rajan, New Delhi-110042, India"

**Head Office and Permanent Communication Address: -** "Lalapur, Po-Kudra, Kudra, Kaimur (Bhabua), Fakhrabad, Bihar-821108, India" and it shall be permanently or temporarily moved to any other location or premise within India as and when required.

**NATURE OF THE TRUST:-**

The trust shall be **Educational and Charitable Trust** having no commercial or profit motive. The properties, securities, moneys and income thereof shall be applied in India solely for the purposes of the trust without any discrimination of race, religion, caste or sex and no portion thereof shall be distributed among the trustees.

**AREA OF OPERATION:-**

All activities of the Trust shall be operated within Indian Jurisdiction only.

**ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST:-**

The objects activities of the trust shall be carried out only in India without any profit motive. The trust shall under no circumstance do or venture into any business directly or indirectly and as such the question of maintenance of separate books of account compliance of the provisions of section 11(4) and proviso to section 80G (5) (1) of the income tax act 1961 does not arise.

**BENEFICIARIES:-**

The benefits of the trust are open to all citizens of India irrespective of caste, creed, race, color, religion, sex, etc.

**THE OBJECTS FOR WHICH THE TRUST IS ESTABLISHED ARE:-**

**EDUCATION OBJECTIVE OF THE TRUST:-**

- To open and run, Educational vocational schools or institutions to bring education within the reach of poor & backward children at National Level.
- To provide libraries, publish books on technical & computer educational, cultural & social subjects, organize discussions & Seminars to impart knowledge & understanding amongst the people.
- To provide hostels & residential accommodation that may be considered necessary for the students for each member of the staff that may be eligible for it.
- To establish & maintain institutions for the handicapped & for adult education, like vocational training in vocations of house hold industry, semi – skilled jobs for self-employment, computer, technical , mechanical, civil, Fashion designing, Beautician, Safety courses, Welding, Social science, languages, fine arts, crafts, music, painting, modeling , Pre Recruitment Trainings for Youth, Yoga, competition entrance coaching etc.
- To provide the best education available in some of the best schools in India  
Emphasis would be on character building, self-discipline & the development of the



creative & social faculties. The Society aims at producing well informed & well assured young children just the kind of children that our country needs.

- To provide the 3,6 month, 1 & 2 Year all kind of technical and non-technical courses /programmes prepare syllabus and execute the examinations and issue certificates throughout India and give franchises throughout India
- To strive to meet changing need of providing comprehensive Technical & computer education to develop varies facets of personality and to impart education to children on the most modern lines & provide an environment congenial to growth & development of the children.
- To arrange & organize the social, cultural & computer educational programmes from time to time.
- To provide free meals, clothes, medicines and other needy things to the poor and needy children of widows.
- To establish, manage, maintain and run Educational, vocational and Technical Institutions anywhere in India, in urban, rural and backward areas and or to provide financial assistance and other facilities to such institutions.
- To promote technical education Courses, computer Courses, fashion designing Courses, Safety courses, Welding Courses, dance, theatres, music, arts, songs, yoga, meditation, creativity of the dancers, artists, musicians, singers, poets, theatre persons and other related to any form of visual and performing arts, Pre Recruitment Trainings for Youth , in particular young professional through performance, seminars, talks and workshops, Competitive Exams coaching's, All types of New generation courses and to achieve high degree of proficiency in various types of India Classical Dance forms.
- To establish, manage maintain and run homes Institutions for the welfare relieve the poor handicapped, old, orphans, widows etc. for their education training to household and cottage industries.
- To promotes harmonies understanding and equal respect for all religions, cultures, races and ideologies and for that purposes to arrange cultural exchange programs, seminars, tours etc. establish, manage maintain and run spiritual co-operative communities and institutes of inter cultural understanding.
- To promote research in the study of Indian system of medicine, homeopathy, and nature cure etc. and ancient Indian culture.
- To give or establish prizes for excellence in the field of (a) Social services (b) human understanding (c) scientific, technical etc. work / research for peace in the country.
- To grant scholarships or provide financial aid to poor / meritorious students in the field of education.
- To complete, publish and distribute or give, financial aid, in the publication of any literature for the promotion of the above objects.
- To open branches where ever considered expedient for the promotion of above objects.
- To Promote and create opportunities for India technical education Courses, computer Courses, fashion designing Courses, Safety courses, Welding Courses

Classical dance & Music traditions, Pre Recruitment Trainings for Youth at the performing level.

- To use the audio – visual media for furtherance of its aims and objects.
- To take up the matter with the competent authorities for common interest of the residents for providing and or improving upon common Park, drainage, roads, Street – lights, scavenging, water and electricity supplies, banking, post office facilities in the area like Park, drainage, roads, street – light, scavenging, water and electricity supplies, banking, post office, bus service facilities, community hall and Barat-Ghar, milk booth, health center, rationing shop, mini – super bazaar, shopping facilities.
- To promote and revive the traditional arts and crafts of India.
- To provide assistance and opportunities to children and young people desirous and eager to learn traditional arts and crafts and folk dances as a profession from best masters and professional in this field and thereby, create in them the concepts that may lead to greater growth in the field of art.
- To promote interest in general public in Indian art culture, music and thus spread this culture far and wide.
- To compile, arrange and make ballets on social issues etc. and show them and help in raising moral character and social awareness of people.
- To mutual exchange of artists, collaborations with other organization etc.
- To maintain run and construct Basti Vikas Kendra, Jan Suvidha Parisar, Roads, Foot Path, Anganvadi, Libraries etc. with the help of concerned Government authorities for giving the education to the students, socially neglected people and children.
- To develop a good teaching faculty and invite experts in the field of Technical education & Indian classical dances especially kathak and promote research, documentation and dissemination on the various aspects of the dance form.
- To translate, print, publish, circulate and distribute appropriate material for distribution of useful knowledge through magazine, pamphlets or other printing mode for the development and promotion, benefit and advancement of music, dance etc.
- To subscribe or give donations, financially or otherwise, to such other societies agencies, associations or institutions who are working in the area of dance & music or involved in the activities which tend to support or air / advance the aims and objects of the trust.
- To receive any grant, donation, fee, support and assistance in any form for the furtherance of the objects of the society.
- To purchase, lease, secure by exchange or license, hire or otherwise acquire any moveable or immovable property and any interest, easement, right and privilege necessary or alter any moveable and immovable property of the Society and undertake such other activities as may be necessary and incidental to the objects of the Trust.
- To frame bye-laws and rules and regulations for the conduct of the business of the Trust and its officers and employees.



- To make adequate arrangements for poor, widows and handicapped orphans, old aged and mentally retired persons.
- To do all such other lawful, acts, deeds and things as are incidental Or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

## **OTHER AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST**

- **Agriculture**
  - a. Development of agricultural land in hilly area through provision of assistance for bounding, leveling and shaping of land, fencing and reclamation, as well as dissemination of farming technology.
  - b. Reclamation of land, soil conservation and forestation.
  - c. To establish Krishi Vigyan Kendra.
  - d. To enhance seed development activities to prepare new hybrids of different varieties.
  - e. To facilitate awareness regarding importance of organic farming.
  - f. To Provide training on sericulture and develop own sericulture farms at grass root, block, district and state level so as to increase the organic farming.
  - g. To Develop own farms with organic farming and providing awareness to people on the importance of organic farming at present.
  - h. Watershed area development.
- **Animal's welfare**
  - a. To investigate and check cruelty against animals to heighten public awareness of the torture perpetrated on animals for the sake research and beauty, glamour and art to discourage and thwart anti-animal activities by taking prompt remedial action.
  - b. To construct sheds for stay of accidental, week, old and awara/ stray animals and birds i.e. shelter house for animals and birds.
  - c. To provide necessary treatment to sick animals & birds.
  - d. To make arrangement for proper fodder/feeds and drinking water to animals& birds.
  - e. To provide AMBULANCE for accidental animals and birds.
- **Awareness generation**
  - a. To conduct awareness generation program amongst students, tribal youth, adolescents, women & general masses in various aspects & fields like NEAC, legal literacy, literacy, primary health care, cultural programs, sports, music, art, science, road safety, pollution control, population issues, enterprise development, information technology, agriculture, RCH, AIDS, immunization, drug abuse, Indian system of medicine and homeopathy, human rights, national integration, promotion of small family norms etc.
- **Appropriate technology**
  - a. To provide appropriate technologies in different aspects of people's daily working and life concerns.
  - b. To provide technical assistance to people.
  - c. To work for technology development in various sectors.
  - d. To facilitate delivery of technology to women and unemployed youth of the rural and urban areas through cooperation from state/central govt. / govt. bodies.

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- **Bio-diversity**
  - a. To organize bio-diversity conservation initiatives amongst all sections of community.
  - b. Conducting environmental education and training in the sphere conservation of forests, wildlife etc. for rural/urban people, especially through organization of camps and lectures.
  - c. To work for maintenance and conservation of bio-diversity.
- **Campaign**
  - a. To conduct campaigns against social evils such as dowry, suicide, corruption, illiteracy, sex ratio, female feticide, child labor and pollution.
  - b. To launch cleanliness, sanitation and health education campaign.
  - c. Facilitate organization of cattle/agriculture camps and awareness of the diseases in both.
  - d. To launch an awareness campaign against infant mortality.
- **Community Services**
  - a. To setup the center for visually handicapped, physically handicapped / disabled, hearing impaired, mentally retarded, multiple handicapped and orphan children and street children.
  - b. Formation of voluntary organization in rural/urban areas.
  - c. Assistance of weaker sections and marginal farmers.
  - d. Development of children (balwaries) and youth clubs and mahila clubs embracing people from all classes.
  - e. Peaceful resolution of local conflicts and disputes.
  - f. Encouraging landless labors, field bounded laborers and marginal farmers to get themselves organizes into vocations like dairy, piggery, poultry, fishery, cottage industries, handicrafts etc. to better their standard living.
  - g. To establish cultural center for artist in both rural and urban areas.
  - h. To establish village library to provide an interaction platform to the villagers with current happening in the world.
  - i. To establish homes shishu grah) for infants for providing them better care.
  - j. To establish student hostel and health gym.
  - k. To arrange science and technology for rural development.
  - l. To setup jan shikshan sansthan.
- **Culture**
  - a. To preserve, develop, promote and disseminate tribal/folk art and culture.
  - b. Cultural heritage of different tribes all over India and abroad.
  - c. To undertake research projects in culture.
  - d. To set up multipurpose cultural complexes/centers.
  - e. To conduct cultural program/activity for fund raising of trust development.
- **Disaster management**
  - a. In the event of natural calamities such as draught, floods and cyclones:
    - i. To undertake voluntary work for victims of calamities through contribution, shramdan, govt. help Etc.
    - ii. To arrange financial assistance from central/state govt. and voluntary organization.
    - iii. To organize and maintain a youth task force for rendering on th spot service during disasters and natural calamities.
    - iv. To maintain and orient the people of flood and drought prone areas in advance to own preventive measures.
- **Energy**
  - a. Encouraging the use of alternative sources of energy, like solar cooker, Bio-gas smokeless chullas etc.

- b. To promote non-conventional energy sources.
- c. To enhance the use of solar energy.
- **Foreign collaboration and contribution**
  - a. To obtain foreign collaboration for transfer of rural technology, marketing processes, etc. from donating agencies in foreign lands.
  - b. To obtain the sanction from Govt. of India (Home Ministry) for receiving foreign contributions.
  - c. To open a separate bank account for foreign contributions and maintain the accounts properly.
  - d. To utilize foreign contributions so received for the up-liftment of weaker sections and marginal farmers in the rural sector with a view to ensuring the greatest good of the greatest number.
- **Forestry**
  - a. To implement various programmes of social forestry, tree plantation, community forestry etc.
  - b. To raise nurseries of various plants for income generating purposes.
- **Gender**
  - a. To implement issues related programs.
  - b. To work for implementation of Pre-Natal Diagnostic Technique (PNDT) Act.
  - c. To implement projects on Gender Sensitization.
- **Handicraft**
  - a. To promote Handicrafts by developing artisans.
  - b. To run projects for development of handicraft through participation of Craft persons.
  - c. To upgrade artisan's skill through appropriate design & technology intervention.
  - d. To provide necessary market support and service to the product/craft persons.
  - e. To implement schemes of sericulture sector, wool sector.
  - f. To run projects, scheme of nation of center for jute diversification.
  - g. To setup training cum production centers for promotion of jute diversification.
- **Health and Family Welfare**
  - a. To run first aid and primary health center.
  - b. To provide facilities to people of mobile dispensaries, Medicare unit.
  - c. To carry out immunization nutrition for health, medical checkup and blood donation programs.
  - d. To propagate family planning schemes by supporting social programs like marking of condoms etc.
  - e. To run reproductive and child health programs.
  - f. To provide free medical aids to the aged men and women, the handicapped, widows, free bounded labors and weaker section of the rural/urban population.
  - g. To provide portable water and rural/urban people.
  - h. To setup hospitals, dispensaries and schools in rural/urban areas, where the existing medical care and educational facilities are inadequate/required.
  - i. To start national health programs for leprosy blindness, TB cancer, RTI/STI/HIV/AIDS and other non-curable diseases.
  - j. To provide counseling services to people living with anxiety of the unknown in pretest and post test counseling for HIV and to work for prevention of STD/HIV.
  - k. To fight against drug abuse.
  - l. To initiate nutrition program for health of women and children.

- m. To provide health training.
- n. To conduct health training eyes camps for the masses.
- o. To help the disabled persons purchase fitting of aids/appliances.
- p. To motivate the people for using the India system of medicine and homeopathy.
- **Help to poor aged**
  - a. To provide free medical aid to the aged, men and women.
  - b. To setup poultry/fishery/dairy units to keep elderly occupied as also to generate income for them.
  - c. To arrange free feeding of elderly rural poor.
  - d. To set up an ASHRAM "apna Ghar" for old people with financial assistance from the central govt. and donations from voluntary agencies.
  - e. To setup DAY CARE Centers for aged.
- **Human Rights**
  - a. To promote & educate Equality, as well as Equity, International Integration, Brotherhood, Non-Violence, Love, Peace, Justice, Protection & Promotion of Human Rights for all.
  - b. To suggest action for violation of rights by armed political groups and terrorists.
  - c. To create an environment as well as an understanding that Human Rights can easily become vulnerable to abuse of various structures and processes of power and to examine the inter-dependence of and linkage between Human Rights and democracy, pluralism, development, ecological balance, peace and harmony at the national and international levels.
  - d. To make people aware of "Human Rights duties", privileges conduct training camps & workshops; establish old age homes, residential/vocational schools & colleges, research & medical colleges and Human Rights Camps.
  - e. To promote art & culture, maintain, encourage, and assist/help setting up Centers for promotion of Human Rights.
  - f. To promote social progress and better standards of life and activity in cooperation with the Government of India and other countries to promote human rights education.
  - g. To develop a more distinctive and effective role for the International Court of Justice to fulfill the Human Rights and spread the messages/values of Human Rights by way of Human Rights education.
  - h. To open training camps and workshops for the development of arts, plays and culture and raise funds through subscriptions, donations, trade to fulfill the aims and objects.
  - i. To establish and conduct centers of treatment and rehabilitation for the victims of violators of Human Rights.
  - j. To actively join hands with the Government of India and other countries to promote Human Rights education and help legal, social and economic discrimination against women and their exploitation in different ways.
  - k. To publish books, encyclopedias, monographs, journals and directories on Human Rights and study and prepare reports on the violation, etc.

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- l. To effectively work for gender inequalities, exploitations and injustice as also to encourage / assist talented artists, poets, singers, writers, social workers, journalists, doctors, judges, etc.
- m. To organize and participate in cultural programmes to foster a spirit of nationalism to achieve co-operation in solving various problems of economic, social, cultural or humanitarian character and in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights
- **Information technology**
  - a. To setup information centers at block/district/state level to help the people about latest developments. If possible these types of center can be setup at village level also.
- **Legal literacy**
  - a. To make rural people conscious of their rights and responsibilities, enabling them to stiff for honest efficient administration, speedier justice and for better education, health and other services.
  - b. To provide women in destitute legal aid and adequate counseling.
- **Livestock management**
  - a. To establish research center for high milk yielding varieties of buffaloes cows etc.
  - b. To setup a semen bank for artificial insemination of animals.
  - c. To establish hospital and mobile Medicare facilities for livestock..
- **Minority Welfare**
  - a. Trust will make best efforts to work on welfare of minority section.
  - b. Trust will work to promote health awareness, education and all other sectors among the minorities.
- **Networking**
  - a. To setup network of village, block, district, state and national and international level NGO's involved in development sector for better working and implementation of various schemes, funding sources and to provide more benefit to target groups.
- **Processing**
  - a. To work for processing of plants, herbs, shrubs etc. for medicines.
  - b. To implement schemes of food processing sector.
  - c. To setup food processing units, food parks etc.
  - d. To carryout manufacturing marketing of low cost building material.
  - e. To understand research & development projects.
  - f. To setup demonstration units & pilot projects.
  - g. To setup food & agro processing units.
- **Publications**
  - a. To setup press & print literature, magazines & newspaper for social welfare.
  - b. To prepare brief curriculum for illiterate people and non-financial education.
- **Research and surveys**
  - a. To conduct various research studies in the field of Agriculture, RCH, Pollution Control, Panchayati Raj, AIDS, Bio-Diversity, Education, Environment, Health, Watershed Management etc.
  - b. To conduct surveys on various topics related to development aspect of community
  - c. To carry out surveys related to the socio-economic aspects of rural and urban life

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- d. To compose herbal garden to enhance methodology of Indian System of Medicine & homeopathy.
- **Seminars/training/camps/workshops**
  - a. To conduct seminars, conferences, lectures at grass root level, District, state and national level on all matters and problems affecting the people.
  - b. To make arrangements for such caliber farmers as are prepared to go abroad to take part in debates and discussion on transfer to latest technology and marketing processes from labs and research centers to land.
  - c. To establish training centers for the farmers to impart knowledge about the latest technology to be adopted by them.
  - d. To organize seminars/camps/workshop/transportations and rallies on the various activities for betterment of the rural & urban poor irrespective of casts and creed.
  - e. To organize voluntary blood donation camps.
  - f. To impart training in horticulture, sericulture, pisci culture, floriculture, poultry, piggery, goat farming, mushroom production, computer application production, stenography, knitting & tailoring, beautification trade, readymade garments, leather goods, handlooms, khadi & jute diversification textile, handicraft & traditional occupation to the poor & needy people and take above mentioned programmes for providing themselves a sustainable employment.
  - g. To setup coaching centers for SC/ST/OBC and others.
  - h. To conduct various refresher courses and orientation training programmers.
  - i. To impart training in co-operative marketing, processing and storage.
  - j. To conduct training for panchayati raj institutions with help of govt.
  - k. To periodically organize seminars, workshops or camps to enlighten people on the aspects of aging and the problems of the aged: how best to tackle these.
- **Sport**
  - a. To establish stadiums (indoor & outdoor) in both rural & urban areas to promote sports activities for normal and disabled friendly.
  - b. To establish swimming pools to enhance swimming activities as sports.
  - c. To organize various sports meets at village, block, district and state level.
  - d. Conduct sports training and competition for disabled /children with special need.
- **Wasteland development**
  - a. To develop wasteland through plantation.
  - b. Regeneration of degraded forest land.
  - c. Developing a system for surface water management for water harvesting.
  - d. Leveling, terracing and bonding of agriculture land in basin areas.
  - e. Demonstration on reclamation of wastelands.
  - f. Social forestry/tree plantation, community forestry.
  - g. Development of pastureland for fodder and fuel.
  - h. To motivate village folk including women to take up wastelands development to raise their own nurseries.
  - i. Growing of fuel & timber spices on private lands in drought prone areas.
  - j. Nurseries and tree plantation on private and common land.
- **Waste management**
  - a. To conduct garbage and solid waste management program in rural and urban areas.
  - b. To setup a recycling plant for waste products to lessen the pollution and harm to the people.



- **Women empowerment**

- a. To facilitate formation of groups of women and farmers in rural /urban areas and thereafter bringing them together on a common platform to address issues through federation, clusters and village development committees.
- b. To facilitate microfinance in the groups.
- c. To facilitate women about their rights and eradication of the differences between girls and boys through trainings and shows.
- d. To organize seminars training shows plays at grass root, block, district and state level about the decreasing sex-ratio in India.

- **Youth activities**

- a. To organize and conduct vocational training courses for youth.
- b. To help youth to acquire knowledge skills' to awaken social consciousness' & responsibility.
- c. To evolve and develop the concept of methodology of community work among youth.
- d. To initiate and organize need-oriented rural/urban development programmes.
- e. To organize and implement schemes that would help poor people to increase their income.
- f. To plan and execute youth exchange programmes; to organize tour and picnics in and out of the country.
- g. To impart education and training of the basis of youth organization methods and practices.
- h. To organize national integration camps.
- i. To conduct various camps i.e. trekking camps, snow skiing, water sports, flying and eco development caps etc.
- j. To organize debates and declamation contest, speech.

**THE OBJECT INCIDENTAL OR ANCILLARY TO THE ABOVE MAIN OBJECT ARE AS FOLLOWS:-**

- a. To raise funds to support the aforementioned Trust objects from within India and abroad.
- b. To solicit, receive, hold and disburse funds to promote the objects stated above and to hold funds and investments in trust.
- c. To open and operate accounts of any description with any bank or Banks for the Trust.
- d. To appeal for and raise funds, subscriptions, grants and loans as the trustees may think fit.
- e. To take on lease or acquire property by purchase or otherwise to promote the objects of the trust without profit motive.
- f. To construct shopping, other complexes and utilize the income for the objects of the trust.
- g. To construct, purchase, take on lease, leave and license, hire or otherwise acquire and to hold, manage, administer and otherwise deal with any movable and immovable properties rights and privileges without the intention of earning profit as the trust board may deem necessary expedient or desirable for the promotion of any of the objects of the trust.
- h. To sell alienate lease give out on lease or license mortgage charge, hypothecate, transfer, surrender dispose of and / or otherwise deal with all or any of the properties funds and assets of the trust without profit motive and only in the rarest



occasions as the trust board may feel deem necessary expedient or desirable for the promotion of any of the objects of the trust.

- i. To appoint or dismiss agents or representatives or other workers on such conditions as may be thought fit by the Board of Trustees.
- j. To enter into any contract or agreement of any other transaction without profit motive for the purpose of promoting of the objects of the trust.
- k. To carry on such other objects as may be incidental to the promotion of any of the Aforesaid objects or any other ancillary objects related to the main objects and but not with the intention of earning profit as may be considered fit by the Board of Trustees.

#### **MANAGEMENT OF THE TRUST:-**

The management of the affairs of the trust shall vest in the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall have all the powers incidental to and necessary for carrying out the administration and management of the trust having regard to the objects and purposes thereof.

#### **THE MANAGING TRUSTEE:**

The President & Managing Trustee – **Mr. Bhanu Pratap Singh** shall be the permanent Managing Trustee of the said trust till his lifetime. After **Mr. Bhanu Pratap Singh** his Wife/son/daughter will be the managing trustee however it shall be opened that the Managing Trustees shall be elected by 2/3rd majority of the said Board of Trustee of the said Trust, in the General Meeting of the Board

#### **BOARD OF TRUSTEE:-**

The Board of Trustees shall be constituted of not less than two and not more than eleven trustees. The trustees appointed at the initiation of this Trust Deed are

#### **POWER DELEGATED TO BOARD OF TRUSTEES:-**

1. The Board of Trustees shall hold the properties of the trust for the objects of the trust stated more elaborately in the objects clause of this trust deed.
2. The Board of Trustees shall hold the amount and all other funds, money and properties which may be received by them or secured to the trust hereafter referred as the Trust Fund on Trust and administer the same subject to the powers provisions agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and contained concerning the same.



3. The Board of Trustees shall collect the income interest and dividends of the "Trust Fund" from time to time and shall there from pay in the first instance all the costs, charges and expenses of trust and shall hold the net balance of the income and the corpus of the trust fund for the objects of the trust here before mentioned.
4. For the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities as mentioned above the Board of Trustees shall be entitled to utilize the fund of trust as well as its income.
5. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to receive upon such terms and conditions as they deem fit. Donations, gifts, subscriptions in each or in kind and to collect funds by public or private appeal for carrying out the objects of the trust.
6. For the purpose of carrying out the object of the trust, the Board of Trustees shall be entitled to purchase properties in the name of the trust represented by its PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE or to construct building and to purchase other movable properties suitable for the functioning of the trust.
7. The Board of Trustees is authorized to sell lease mortgage or otherwise deal with any of the properties of the trust both movable and immovable as may be found necessary from time to time.
8. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to let out its building or portion thereof as is required for the purpose of the trust and also other immovable properties, which from part of the trust on such terms and conditions as they deem proper.
9. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sell by public auction or by private treaty as they may deem proper, any movable or immovable property forming part of the trust upon such terms and conditions as they may deem proper and beneficial to the trust.
10. The Board of Trustees shall have power to raise loans or obtain advance for the purpose of the trust with or without security and upon such terms and conditions as they deem proper.
11. The Board of Trustees shall invest the money and funds of the trust not immediately required in any one or more of the methods prescribed in section 11(5) of the income tax act 1961 as amended from time to time read with section 13(1) (d) of the income tax Act, 1961.
12. The PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE or any committee appointed by the trustees shall be entitled to engage such staff and servants upon such terms and conditions as they may deem proper.
13. The Board of Trustees is entitled to file lawsuits on behalf of the trust and likewise defend any action taken against the trust and also compromise and compound such cases and the expenses incurred therefore shall be met out of the funds of the trust, the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE shall represent the trust in all the legal proceedings.
14. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to frame rules and regulations for the conduct of their activities and for the administration of the trust and to alter, amend or vary such rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem proper. However, no amendments in the trust deed altering the basic character of the trust and repugnant to the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of income tax having jurisdiction over the trust.



15. The Board of Trustees shall have power to enter into and carry out arrangements for joint working or for amalgamate with any other trust, society or institution having charitable objects on such terms and conditions as they may deem fit.
16. The Board of Trustees shall have such other powers as may be found reasonable or necessary for the purpose of proper implementation of the objects of the trust.

#### **RETIREMENT OF TRUSTEES:-**

1. Any Trustee may retire on giving three months' notice in writing thereof to the Board of Trustees.
2. A Trustee shall automatically cease to be and shall vacate the office of the trustee on the happening of any of the following:
  - a. By death or resignation or retirement
  - b. If he becomes of unsound mind
  - c. If he is adjudged insolvent or if he applied to be so adjudged.
  - d. If he is convicted of any offence (other than an offence not involving moral turpitude) and is sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment;
  - e. If in the opinion of the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE and majority of other trustees the continuation of any trustee in the board is detrimental to the interest of the trust.

#### **APPOINTMENT OF NEW TRUSTEE:-**

The trustees hereby appointed in the board are life trustee and in the event of any vacancy by resignation or otherwise new trustee shall be appointed by the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE of the trust.

#### **MEETING OF TRUSTEES:-**

1. The trustee shall hold meeting at such intervals as they may decide however at least once in every year such annual meeting being known as "Annual General Meeting" shall be held. At every Annual general meeting of the trust the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE shall read before the meeting a report of the activities since the previous annual general meeting and lay before the Board of Trustees the audited income and expenditure account and balance sheet of the trust for the previous accounting year.
2. The Quorum for the meeting shall be two.
3. The Board of Trustees shall transact any business that may be specified in the agenda or otherwise agreed by the board members present.
4. The vote of the majority present and voting at the meeting shall prevail and in case of equality of votes the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE shall have a casting vote.
5. No act or resolution of the board of trustee shall be invalid merely by reason of the existence of one or more vacancies in the Board of Trustees.
6. For every meeting a notice of at least seven days must be given. The notice may be given by hand delivery addressed to the respective addresses of the trustees registered with the trust but the accidental omission to given such notice or non-receipt thereof by any trustee shall not invalidate the proceedings at any meeting of the Board of Trustees.
7. All the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be presided over by the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE of the trust and in his absence any one of the trustees may be requested by the Board of Trustees to be the Chairman of the said meeting.



## POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE:-

1. To be in charge of and keep in safe custody of all the funds of the trust and maintain proper books of accounts and shall convene all meetings of the subcommittee if any constituted by the Board of Trustees.
2. To be in charge of all the records and properties of the Board of Trustees.
3. To directly control all employees of the trust.
4. To keep accurate minutes of all the meetings of the Board of Trustees this shall be confirmed at the next meeting.
5. To prepare the agenda of the various meetings and circulate the same.
6. To see that the resolution of the Board of Trustees and those of various committees are put into execution.
7. To carry on all correspondence in the name and on behalf of the trust and shall promptly carryout the orders and resolutions of the board of trustees. All communications meant for the trust shall ordinarily be addressed to the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE.
8. He shall maintain all account books vouchers and receipts of various forms of income and expenditure of the trust.
9. For each institution project and branch of the trust he is authorized to keep with him in cash such sum that may be required for the day to day affairs of the trust.
10. The PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE shall have power to take all disciplinary actions on appointed staff members of the trust such as removal, dismissal etc. after following the principles of natural justice and fair play.
11. He shall submit to the Board of Trustees a detailed account of receipts and disbursements of the trust duly checked and signed if and when required by the Board of Trustees. He shall also place before the Annual general meeting of the trust a balance sheet and income and expenditure account for each year signed by any two members of the Board of Trustees and duly certified by the auditor.

## INDEMNICATION OF TRUSTEES:-

1. No trustee shall be personally liable for any loss not attributable to his / her own dishonesty or of commission by him/her of an act amounting to a breach of trust.
2. Every trustee shall be indemnified out of the funds of the trust in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made of any of the money of the trust funds unless such loss is occasioned by misappropriation or fraud by such trustee.

## COVENANTS BY THE TRUSTEES:-

Each of the trustees covenants with the trust that he/ she will on vacating office do and execute all such acts deeds and things as shall be necessary to vest the funds of the trust and all securities and investments which may then be standing in his/her name as representing the trust. Should any controversy or doubt arise regarding the purpose, meaning or construction of these presents or any of the matters relating to the trust the decision of the board of trustee shall be final.

## ADVISORY COMMITTEES:-

The board may constitute any finance committees entrusting the function of raising funds for the trust or other committee and the committees shall hold their office for a period of 3



years and subsequent committee shall be composed and constituted by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees may frame rules by laws or regulations regarding the appointment of committees, subcommittee and their obligations regarding expenses, salaries and duties and other matters connected with the committee.

### ACCOUNTING YEAR, ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:-

The financial period of the trust shall be twelve months commencing from April and ending with March. The accounts of the trust shall be regularly maintained every year and the accounts shall be closed by 31st March and the same shall be audited by a qualified chartered accountant.

### BANK ACCOUNT:-

Bank account can be opened in the name of the trust in any of the nationalized / private / scheduled / cooperative / regional / rural banks, MNC or other banks or financial institutions as the board of trustee may decide from time to time. The said account shall be operated by either the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE or jointly by one or more of the trustees, for and on behalf of the trust as authorized by the Board of Trustees. The PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE are empowered to execute any documents for opening or raising loans for the objects of the trust from any of the above said banks.

### CORPUS FUND:-

The initial amount settled upon the trustee is Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) on which the stamp duty has been paid. At present the trust has no other movable or immovable property except the nucleus amount of Rs. 1,000 /-

### PROPERTIES OF TRUST:-

1. Documents related to purchase, sale, lease and mortgage of properties shall be in the name of the trust represented by the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE.
2. If desired a subcommittee may be formed to look after and supervise the properties of the trust.
3. Purchase and sale of properties shall be done as decided by the board of trustees.

### FINANCE OF THE TRUST:-

1. The Authors have donated a sum of Rs.1, 000/- in total as initial fund of the trust.
2. Further donation of the Authors and amount donated by well-wishers will be included in the finance of the trust.
3. Fees collected from students studying in the various institutions under the trust shall also be included in the funds of the trust.
4. Income from properties and interest from investments and grant and aids from government and other institutions will also be included in the funds of the trust.
5. Amounts received for the trust shall be deposited in a bank as may be decided by the Board of trustees. An amount as fixed by the Board of Trustees may be retained with the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE to meet current expenses.
6. The bank accounts shall be opened in the name of trust and shall be operated by either the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE or jointly by one or more of the trustees namely for and on behalf of the trust.



7. The financial year of the trust shall be from April to March of corresponding year. All the accounts of the trust shall be closed at the end of each financial year and a statement of receipt and expenditure and a balance sheet shall be prepared and signed by the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE and approved by the Board of Trustees and audited by an auditor appointed on that behalf. Such statement and balance sheet shall be conclusive proof of the financial state of the trust.

#### **EXPENDITURE OF THE TRUST FUNDS:-**

1. All expenses for the management of the trust affairs shall be incurred by the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE as per resolutions passed in the meetings of the Board of Trustees and shall be paid out of the trust funds under proper vouchers. Similarly all receipts towards the trust funds shall be duly accounted for in the books of accounts with proper receipts wherever practicable.
2. All the books, accounts, records and papers etc. of the trust shall be in the trust office under the custody of the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE.
3. Any record requires to be taken out of the office for any purpose in connection with the affairs and activities of the trust may be taken out with the knowledge of the PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE.

#### **SOURCES OF FUND TO THE TRUST:-**

The Authors in order to do augment funds for the objects stated above empower the Board of Trustees to receive donation, gifts, voluntary contribution grant in aid assistance from the donors either towards corpus or for the revenue expenditure, to execute the objects of the trust as in the object clause from all i.e. individual Government institutional donors either in India or abroad for the furtherance of the objects as specified in the object as specified in the object clause.

#### **INVESTMENT OF THE FUNDS:-**

The investment of the funds of the trust shall be in accordance with provisions of section 11(5) read with section 13(1) (d) of the income tax act 1961

#### **APPLICATION OF FUNDS:-**

1. The income and funds of the trust will solely be utilized towards the objects no portion of it will be utilize for payment to the Authors, trustees, members of the committee, office bearers by way of profits, dividends, interest, bonus or otherwise.
2. Corpus fund or capital fund or earmarked fund shall be invested in such manner as prescribed under section 11(5) of the income tax act 1961 till the fund is defrayed for capital or revenue expenditure for the maintenance and sustenance of the objects for which the fund is created.
3. Where the income of the relevant year is not applied for charitable purposes, the trust may accumulate or set apart either the whole or part of its income for future application for the purpose of the trust by abiding the provisions of the income tax act 1961.

#### **REMUNERATION:-**

The income and funds of the trust will solely be utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to the Authors, trustees by way of profit, dividend, interest etc.



### AMENDMENT:-

The board by passing a resolution in the board meeting will authorize PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE to amend the trust deed subject to the following covenants:

1. The amendment of the trust will be carried out only with the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax.
2. The amendment would not extend to alter the basic character or objects of the trust and further no such amendment which may prove to be repugnant of sections 2(15), 11, and 13 and 80G, 35 (1) and (2), 35AC of the income tax act shall be made.

### IRREVOCABILITY OF THE TRUST:-

This trust is an incurables trust and the trustees shall have no right or authority to revoke it, but the board if decided by two third majority if its members shall have power to associate or amalgamate with other trust/trustee/ or society/societies constituted for more or less with similarity progresses/objectives.

This trust shall not be profit making organizations and it shall be a charitable trust. Income if any dived from/for the trust shall only be utilized for the aims and objectives described above. The trustee/trustees shall be utilized for wage, honorarium and/or requirement of the actual expenses by any one or all of them in connection with the responsibility they are holding and the discharge of her/his their functions are exceeded to them/him/her by the board.

### DISSOLUTION OR WINDING UP:-

In the event of dissolution of the TRUST, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed, after obtaining prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax (Exemption) New Delhi, to other Trusts having similar objectives and who have been granted registration u/s 12 AA of the Income Tax Act 1961. In no circumstances it shall be distributed in any manner, to any member of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related concerns.

### OTHER GENERAL CLAUSES:-

- a. Every property of the trust movable or immovable shall be kept in the name of the trust.
- b. Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements made on account of the trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the trustees and the same shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers at least once in every year by a chartered accountant or a firm of chartered accountants as may be appointed by the trustees.
- c. The income and fund of the trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profit interest dividend etc.
- d. The trustees shall be reimbursed out of the trust funds the actual expenses incurred in carrying out the activities of the trust.
- e. The PRESIDENT & MANAGING TRUSTEE shall sign all documents, contracts and agreements on behalf of the trust, other than documents related to purchase, sale, lease and mortgage of trust properties.
- f. No activity of the trust shall be carried outside India.



- g. The benefits of the trust shall be open to all Indians, irrespective of caste or creed or religion.
- h. The trust shall not carry on any activity other than those activities which are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the trust.
- i. If for any reason the objects of the trust cannot be achieved or for any other reason thought fit by the trustees the assets and liabilities of the trust may be transferred to any other trust society or institution whose objects are charitable and registered under section 12AA of the income tax act 1961 and having exemption under section 80G and under no circumstances distributed among the trustees.
- j. The Trust shall in future attempt to raise its own funds in order to carry out its earlier mentioned objects for which necessary legal provisions such as 12(A), 80G, 35(1) & (2), 35AC, FCRA (Foreign Contribution Regulation Act) and other appropriate legal entities shall be applied and obtained in order to fulfill its objectives from time to time.
- k. The trust has no movable or immovable properties except the corpus fund.
- l. The trust activities carry out only in India.

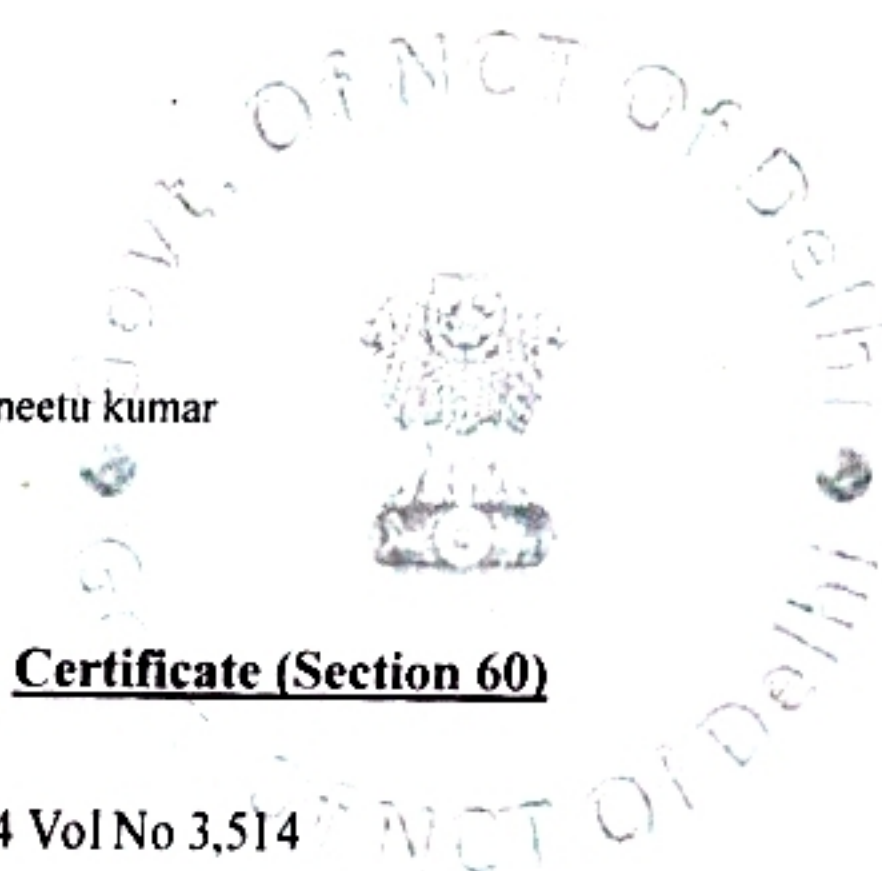
